<b>Total Standard of Care</b>	50 hours
<b>Pre-Read</b>	10 hours (approximate / student dependent)
<b>Total Training</b>	40 hours (4 days; 10 hours per day)
<b>In-Class Training</b>	25 hours (approximate / student dependent)
<b>Field Training</b>	15 hours (approximate / student dependent)
<b>TRAINING STANDARDS</b>	
<b>Student-to-Instructor Ratio</b>	10 : 1
<b>Scope of Training</b>	Non-urban
<b>PREREQUISITES</b>	
<b>Age</b>	16 years (contact Operations Director if younger)
<b>CPR (C)</b>	Current certification (within 1-year)
<b>Physical &amp; Mental Fitness</b>	Candidates are required to sign a declaration of physical and mental fitness
<b>REQUIREMENTS FOR INITIAL CERTIFICATION</b>	
<b>Attendance</b>	100% attendance is required
<b>Progressive Evaluation</b>	Yes
<b>Final Written Evaluation</b>	100 multiple choice (80% grade must be achieved)
<b>Final Practical Evaluation</b>	Scenarios and skill-stations (80% grade must be achieved)

<b>Re-certification</b>	2-year certification
