STANDARD OF CARE	
Total Course Training	100 hours (10 days; 10 hours per day / student dependant; includes evaluation process)
In-Class Training	40% (approximate / student dependent)
Field Training	60% (approximate / student dependent)
Student-to-Instructor Ratio	Goal – 8:1, Maximum 10:1
Scope of Training	Non-urban, EMS based
PRE-REQUISITES	
Age	Minimum 19 years (contact PEAK's Operations Director if younger)
CPR ('C' or higher)	Current certification (within 2 years)
Physical & Mental Fitness	Candidates are required to sign a self-declaration of physical and mental fitness
Pre-Reading	40-60 hours – OEC 5 th edition textbook (approximate / student dependent)
Language	Must speak and write English fluently
REQUIREMENTS FOR INITIAL CERTIFICATION	
Attendance	90% attendance is required to attend an NUEC 3 evaluation process
Progressive Evaluation	Students must receive an instructor's recommendation prior to attending an NUEC 3 evaluation process
Final Written Evaluation	100 multiple choice (minimum 80% grade must be achieved)
Final Practical Evaluation	Scenarios and skill stations (minimum 80% grade must be achieved)
REQUIREMENTS FOR NUEC 3 CERTIFICATION MAINTENANCE	
Annual Requirements	Attend an <i>Annual Skills Update Course</i> (ASU); yearly, 1-2 days; site-specific
Re-certification	<i>Annual Skills Update Course</i> (ASU) Cycle 'C' (1-2 days; site-dependent) includes a practical and written evaluation process
