Total Course Training	100 hours (10 days; approx. 10 hrs. per day / student dependent)
In-Class Training	40% (approx. / student dependent)
Field Training	60% (approx. / student dependent)
Student-to-Instructor Ratio	Goal – 8:1
Scope of Training	Non-urban, EMS based
PRE-REQUISITES	
Previous Qualifications	Standard First Aid certification within 1 year (**Applies to Alberta courses only)
Age	Minimum 19 years (contact PEAK's Registrar & Administrative Manager if younger)
Physical & Mental Fitness	Candidates are required to sign a self-declaration of physical and mental fitness
Pre-Reading	40-60 hours – OEC 5 th edition textbook (approx. / student dependent)
Language	Must speak and write English fluently
REQUIREMENTS FOR NUEC 3 CERTIFICATION	
Attendance	90% attendance is required
Progressive Evaluation	Yes
Final Written Evaluation	100 multiple choice (minimum 80% grade must be achieved)
Final Practical Evaluation	Scenarios and skill stations (minimum 80% grade must be achieved)
REQUIREMENTS FOR NUEC 3 CERTIFICATION MAINTENANCE	
Annual Requirements / Recertification	Attend an <i>Annual Skills Update Course</i> (ASU) annually; 1-2 days (site-specific) NOTE: ASU Cycle 'D' includes a practical and written evaluation process
