When the listed Indications are met, contraindications ruled out and conditions achieved, a Qualified Provider¹ may administer acetaminophen and ibuprofen to patients requiring analgesia.

INDICATIONS FOR USE – ACETAMINOPHEN & IBUPROFEN

Patients requiring analgesia resulting from trauma ONLY and who meet the following criteria:

- Hemodynamically stable (sustained vital signs within normal limits); **AND**
- Alert, oriented and able to comply with instructions

CONTRAINDICATIONS OF USE

1. Acetaminophen and/or ibuprofen use within the last 4 hours
2. Previous hypersensitivity to acetaminophen, ibuprofen or other non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs
3. Liver &/or renal disease
4. History of gastrointestinal ulcers/bleeding
5. Pregnancy

PEDIATRIC DOSING		
AGE	Acetaminophen – Children's Tylenol Fever & Pain 160 mg per 5 ml (prepared)/32 mg per 1ml	Ibuprofen – Children's Advil 100 mg per 5 ml (prepared) / 20 mg per 1 ml
4 - 6	7.5 ml (240 mg)	10 ml (200 mg)
7 – 8	10 ml (320 mg)	12.5 ml (250 mg)
9 – 10	12.5 ml (400 mg)	15 ml (300 mg)
11 – 12	15 ml (480 mg)	19 ml (380 mg)
ADULT DOSING		
AGE	Acetaminophen Tylenol Rapid Relief Gel Caps 500 mg per capsule	Ibuprofen Advil Extra Strength Liqui-Gels 400 mg per capsule
>12	2 X 500 mg = 1000 mg	1 X 400 mg = 400 mg

CONDITIONS OF USE (ALL CONDITIONS MUST BE MET PRIOR TO ACETAMINOPHEN & IBUPROFEN ADMINISTRATION)

- Completed a Primary Assessment
- Provided and maintained all necessary critical interventions
- Activated the local emergency response system (& notified EMS if required)
- Conducted a targeted Past Medical History
- Obtained and recorded baseline vital signs including: LOR, RR, HR, SpO₂, Skin Temp. & Condition
- Ensure indications are met and contraindications are ruled out
- Informed patient of beneficial effects and possible adverse effects
- Obtained patient consent
- Acetaminophen and Ibuprofen are to be administered as outlined in PEAK's APTP Training Manual
