Age	Minimum 14 years (contact PEAK's Registrar and Administrative Manager if younger)
Language	Must speak and write English fluently
Physical & Mental Fitness	Candidates are required to sign a declaration of physical and mental fitness

Attendance	100% attendance is required
Progressive Evaluation	Yes
Final Written Evaluation	20 multiple choice (minimum 80% grade must be achieved)
Final Practical Evaluation	Progressive
