STANDARD OF CARE	
Total Course Training	40 hours (4 days; 10 hours per day / student dependent; includes evaluation process)
In-Class Training	40% (approximate / student dependent)
Field Training	60% (approximate / student dependent)
Student-to-Instructor Ratio	Goal – 8:1, Maximum 10:1
Scope of Training	Non-urban, EMS Based
PREREQUISITES	
Age	Minimum 16 years (contact PEAK's Registrar and Administrative Manager if younger)
Language	Must speak and write English fluently
Physical & Mental Fitness	Candidates are required to sign a declaration of physical and mental fitness
REQUIREMENTS FOR INITIAL CERTIFICATION	
Attendance	100% attendance is required
Progressive Evaluation	Yes
Final Written Evaluation	100 multiple choice (minimum 80% grade must be achieved)
Final Practical Evaluation	Scenarios and skill-stations (minimum 80% grade must be achieved)
REQUIREMENTS FOR MAINTENANCE OF CERTIFICATION	
Annual Requirements	Attend an <i>Annual Skills Update Course</i> (ASU); annually, 1-2 days; site-specific
Re-certification	<i>Annual Skills Update Course</i> (ASU). NOTE: Cycle 'D' (1-2 days; site-dependent) includes a practical and written formative evaluation process
