STANDARD OF CARE

Training Course Standard	100 - 110 hours
Total Course Training	40 hours (4 days; approx. 10 hrs. per day / student dependent)
In-Class Training	40% (approx. / student dependent)
Field Training	60% (approx. / student dependent)
Student-to-Instructor Ratio	10:1
Scope of Training	Non-Urban, Professional Responder Based

PRE-REQUISITES

Current Qualifications	<p>Must have a current accredited Advanced First Aid Certificate (minimum 70 hours), such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Non-Urban Emergency Care 3 - Occupational First Aid Level 3 - Emergency Medical Responder - Primary Care Paramedic
Age	Minimum 19 years (contact PEAK's Registrar if younger)
Physical & Mental Fitness	Candidates are required to submit a self-declaration of physical and mental fitness
Pre-Reading	20-40 hours (student dependent) – current Outdoor Emergency Care (OEC) textbook
Language	Must speak and write English fluently

REQUIREMENTS FOR NUEC 3 CERTIFICATION

Attendance	100% attendance is required
Progressive Evaluation	Yes (formative evaluation process embedded)
Final Written Evaluation	100 multiple choice (minimum 80% grade must be achieved)
Final Practical Evaluation	<p>Scenarios: minimum of 3 scenarios (1 x minor trauma, 1 x major trauma, 1 x medical)</p> <p>Skill Stations: minimum of 2 skill stations (CPR/AED, airway mgmt., minor wound, etc.)</p> <p>(minimum 80% grade must be achieved on all practical components)</p>
